### **A Month Of Murray**

#### **Sunday 8/3**

**The Royal Tenenbaums** 2001 | R | 110 minutes

The early promise of Tenenbaum child prodigies Chas, Margot and Richie is short-circuited by the flaws of their father, family patriarch Royal, in Wes Anderson's New York fairy tale about a dysfunctional clan of eccentrics.

**Stripes** 1981 | R | 106 minutes

After losing everything, an indolent sad sack impulsively joins the U.S. Army and cajoles his best friend into enlisting, too. But after making it through boot camp, the duo find themselves in the midst of an international incident.

#### **Sunday 8/10**

**Rushmore** 1998 | R | 93 minutes

Wunderkind Max Fischer, a sophomore at upscale Rushmore Academy, sees his world turn topsy-turvy when he's smitten with widowed first-grade teacher Rosemary Cross. To win her heart, Max enlists the aid of school benefactor Herman J. Blume.

**Where The Buffalo Roam** 1980 | R | 96 minutes

In this comedy based on the semi-biographical stories of Hunter S. Thompson, the gonzo journalist stumbles through a series of wacky adventures (some true, some imagined) from 1968 to 1972, often with his attorney, Carl Lazlo, by his side.

#### **Sunday 8/17**

**The Life Aquatic with Steve Zissou** 2004 | R | 119 minutes

Eccentric oceanographer Steve Zissou and his crew find themselves in troubled waters when they attempt to track down the mysterious "jaguar shark" that ate Zissou's partner while they were filming a documentary of their latest adventure.

**Scrooged** 1988 | PG-13 | 101 minutes

Cold-hearted TV exec Bill Murray is about to discover the true meaning of Christmas -- the hard way. Director Richard Donner's wild, woolly spin on Dickens's *A Christmas Carol* sees Murray visited by three high-spirited spirits.

#### **Sunday 8/24**

**Caddyshack** 1980 | R | 98 minutes

This comedy classic follows the travails of young caddy Danny Noonan as he gets tangled in high jinks involving the eclectic and ridiculous members of Bushwood Country Club. Meanwhile, assistant groundskeeper Carl Spackler battles a pesky gopher.

**Lost In Translation** 2003 | R | 101 minutes

Two lost souls visiting Tokyo -- the young, neglected wife of a photographer and a washed-up movie star shooting a TV commercial -- find an odd solace and pensive freedom to be real in each other's company, away from their lives in America.

#### **Sunday 8/31**

**Groundhog Day** 1993 | PG | 101 minutes

Sent to cover the annual appearance of world-famous groundhog Punxsutawney Phil, a self-centered TV weatherman unleashes his bitterness -- and soon realizes he's doomed to repeat Groundhog Day until he learns that his actions can affect the outcome.

**Ghostbusters** 1984 | PG | 105 minutes

After losing their academic posts at a prestigious college, a team of parapsychologists creates a business exterminating ghouls, hobgoblins and supernatural pests -- and are soon hired by a cellist to purge her digs of a demon.
